All registrations are subject to the following Terms and Conditions.

In the event that workshops are cancelled by the Riverina Millinery Association and the delegate does not wish to enrol in another, a refund of fees paid will be granted.

Delegates wishing to switch workshops may do so at any time up to 2 weeks before commencement of workshop providing there is a vacancy available.

This request must be received in writing and sent directly to admin@riverinamillinery.com.au. Please note a switching fee of \$50 will be enforced.

Delegates who cancel or withdraw from Workshops will receive a refund of fees paid, minus an administration charge of \$50. Those cancelling or withdrawing after the cancellation time will receive no refund. Again, requests to receive a refund must be submitted in writing to the above address.
